What is FX Trade Off

- Following on from a successful campaign in 2017 Bank of Ireland Global Markets, in association with Share Navigator, is giving students an opportunity to learn about the Foreign Exchange (FX) markets.
- Each student will receive a real-time simulated trading account funded with \$1,000,000. Over a 5 week period, each student will compete by trading the global currency markets, and the students with the highest return on investments will win prizes.
- This year, we are introducing a new dynamic to the competition, an intervarsity society competition, with big cash prizes for the top performing society in each university*.
- We will also be bringing the competition to UL and NUIG for the first time this year in addition to UCD, DCU, Trinity and UCC. However, all students studying in Irish 3rd level colleges are eligible to compete for individual prizes.
- Throughout the competition Bank of Ireland Global Markets will provide Market Updates, trading tutorials and general advice to students through twitter, video and inperson presentations.





* Only universities with Bank of Ireland Branches on campus can win intervarsity prizes.

Registration

Process

✓ Registration opens on 17th September

- All entrants will be placed on a waitlist initially
- Students who attend launch nights will be given priority
- FX Trade Off team will have final discretion over who is admitted to the competition - this will ensure fair distribution of places between universities and societies
- As launch nights progress, FX Trade Off team will verify waitlisted users and grand them access to the competition. At this point, the student will be given a practice account to use until the competition starts.
